Nursery Proposals

Many of our parents will be aware that our Nursery Unit has been oversubscribed in the last few academic years in relation to admissions; with some of our current primary school parents unable to secure a placement for their child in the nursery. Currently we can only offer 26 places for the part-time nursery session, while we have 58 for Primary 1.

The Board of Governors and I are very keen to consult with parents on your views and interest in a second afternoon session in the Nursery. In the next few days, a consultation survey will be available for parents. We would ask as many parents as possible to contribute your views, in the hope that we can use this information to support any future development proposals to the Department of Education. Your support in this is much appreciated.
