Our theme this month is 'People at Work'







This month, we will be learning about different jobs people do - jobs in our school (eg. lollipop lady), jobs people do to help us stay healthy and safe (eg. dentist, police), jobs people do in shops (eg. hairdresser), and jobs people do to provide for us (eg. farmer, chef, binman). To help us with part of our learning, we would have been having visits from various members of the community (eg. police, vet, optician). Our colour this month is pink.




The shape we are learning about is a cube.



We will be talking about the number 10.

The concept we will look at is positional language - for example, beside, behind, in front, over, under, above, below, through, between, etc.

Our Personal Development focus this month is 'Being Tidy' and taking care of our toys and our classroom.



Our Physical Development focus is to learn some simple games skills, like how to follow rules, take turns, and work together as part of a team.



The nursery rhymes and songs we are learning are written out for you overleaf so you can have fun practising them at home.

- 2. What sort of uniforms do they wear? (hats, boots, coats, etc)
- 3. What tools do they need? (computer, hammer, hoses, etc)
- 4. What vehicle do they use for their job? (car, van, lorry, engine, truck, tractor, bike)
- 5. What noises do they make doing their work? (siren, banging, snipping, drilling, etc)
